The Basic Urodynamics Course is predominantly a 2-day lecture based course designed to evaluate the place of Urodynamics in Clinical Urology and Gynaecology

The main course on **Tuesday 8th & Wednesday 9th April** places emphasis on the clinical application of Urodynamics techniques, but to allow perspective, the course will include a discussion on lower urinary tract dysfunction and its assessment. Topics include: Anatomy and Physiology, Basic techniques, Urodynamics Equipment, Clinical Applications and Management in Urology, Gynaecology and Spinal Injuries.

In addition there is an optional practical day on **7th April**. This day is intended for doctors, nurses and technicians with little or no Urodynamic experience. Numbers are limited to 24 for this day and offers an introduction to the practical aspect of urodynamics
